

From the Secretary

The Board of Trustees has approved an increase in our yearly dues of \$2.50 for members. The by-laws of the Lodge must be changed to reflect this increase. By Statutes, Section 17.060 any amendments "...shall be proposed in writing, read at a regular meeting of the Lodge and laid over for a vote at a regular Lodge meeting to be held not less than two (2) weeks nor more than ten(10) weeks thereafter." Discussion and voting for this by-law change will be Tuesday, February 18th at 7:30 pm.

By-Law Change for Raymond Elks Lodge #1292

Article X: Fees and Dues, Section 2 (b) REGULAR LODGE DUES

Change from: The regular Lodge dues shall be \$50.50 per year, which shall not include the Grand Lodge per capita fee, the Grand Lodge per capita insurance assessment, and State Association dues.

Change to: The regular Lodge dues shall be \$53.00 per year, which shall not include the Grand Lodge per capita fee, the Grand Lodge per capita insurance assessment, and State Association dues.

Article X: Fees and Dues, Section 2 (c) LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Change from: In addition to the amounts set forth under (a) above, each Life Member and/or Honorary Life Member shall pay \$20.50 towards Lodge administration expense.

Change to: In addition to the amounts set forth under (a) above, each Life Member and/or Honorary Life Member shall pay \$23.00 towards Lodge administration expense.
