## **Proposed By-Laws and House Rules Changes**

The by-laws of the Lodge must be changed to reflect this increase. By Statutes, Section 17.060 any amendments "...shall be proposed in writing, read at a regular meeting of the Lodge and laid over for a vote at a regular Lodge meeting to be held not less than two (2) weeks nor more than ten(10) weeks thereafter." Discussion and voting for this by-law change will be Tuesday, September 21, 2021 at 7:30 pm

#### ARTICLE IV: MEETINGS Section 2.

<u>Change from:</u> The regular hour of meeting shall be 7:30PM; but at any time, however, the regular meeting may be held at an hour to be determined by vote of the Lodge to that effect at the previous meeting, provided that written notice of such change of meeting hour shall be given to all the Members.

<u>Change to:</u> The regular hour of meeting shall be 7:00PM; but at any time, however, the regular meeting may be held at an hour to be determined by vote of the Lodge to that effect at the previous meeting, provided that written notice of such change of meeting hour shall be given to all the Members.

#### ARTICLE IV-A: Exemplification of Rituals Section 1.

<u>Change from:</u> The lodge shall not allow for the use of alternative forms of the Opening and/or Closing Rituals, as approved by the Grand Lodge.

<u>Change to:</u> The lodge shall allow for the use of alternative forms of the Opening and/or Closing Rituals, as approved by the Grand Lodge.

#### ARTICLE V: ELECTIVE OFFICERS AND DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY Section 1.

<u>Change from:</u>. For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive as compensation \$5600 dollars per annum, payable monthly.

<u>Change to:</u> For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive as compensation \$7200 dollars per annum, payable monthly.

#### ARTICLE V: ELECTIVE OFFICERS AND DUTIES OF THE TREASURER Section 1.

<u>Change from:</u> He shall be required to give bond to the Lodge in the sum of \$5,000 dollars for the faithful performance of his duties, and shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of \$2,800 dollars per annum, payable monthly.

<u>Change to:</u> He shall be required to give bond to the Lodge in the sum of \$5,000 dollars for the faithful performance of his duties, and shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of \$3,600 dollars per annum, payable monthly.

CHECKS: Added the following: The Club Manager can approve cashing of a check issued by Raymond Elks Lodge or Ladies of the Elks if funds are available.

PROPERTY: Added the following: Proprietary books, magazines, periodicals or newspapers must not be removed from the Club.

SUSPENSION AND DISIPLINE: Changed to: The House Committee on recommendation of the Manager has the authority to suspend any member from Club Privileges for any infraction of the above rules (Sec. 16.041 of the Laws of the Order).


