 Summer is finally here so we hope to see you at a dinner or event at the Elks real soon. Jackie Gurr, Secretary





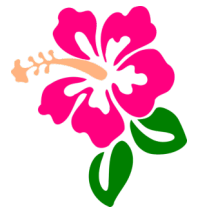
